**Dr. Olivia Kituuka,**

Dr. Kituuka is a general surgeon who has lectured in the Department of Surgery at Makerere University College of Health Sciences, Mulago since 2009. She is currently attached to the Upper GI and Hepatobiliary Unit in Mulago Hospital, where she assists in running outpatient clinics, managing the surgical wards and operating in both major and minor theatres. Dr. Kituuka has a special interest in minimally invasive surgical techniques, and carries out diagnostic and some therapeutic endoscopy. She serves as director of Essential Surgical Skills for both undergraduate and postgraduate learners at Makerere, and played an integral role in the development of the surgical lab there. Dr. Kituuka has served as Vice President of the Uganda Gastroenterology Society since May 2013, and President-Elect of the Association of Surgeons of Uganda since February 2013.
