

Dr. Ilun Yang, CBD Lead General Surgery Residency Training Program

Dr. Yang will lead the implementation of CBD in the General Surgery residency training program through the provision of support and guidance to both faculty and residents as adjustments are made to the program in areas such as curriculum design (e.g. the mapping of EPAs and milestones), and the creation of new tools for assessment/evaluation. He will also assist in the creation of a competence committee, and identify opportunities to promote faculty and resident awareness of the CBD initiative and process, and address any questions or concerns as they arise.

Dr. Yang will work closely with, and report to, Dr. M. Marcaccio, General Surgery residency program director, and will liaise with department and Faculty of Health Sciences leaders in the area of CBD to ensure as seamless a transition as possible for the General Surgery residency training program. Royal College Specialty Committee CBD workshops in General Surgery will commence later this month, with the official implementation of CBD in the General Surgery residency training program scheduled for July 1, 2019.
